Introduction

This handout style can be used for short points.

Or for longer sentences or paragraphs.

It uses indentation to show items and sub-items. Different levels of bullet point would be an alternative.

The QR code above can be changed to point to whatever location is desired.

Or the LaTeX to generate it can be deleted if it is not wanted.

In that case you may wish to delete the table that contains it and insert your heading as ordinary lines of text (perhaps bold and centred).

Points in the .tex file

Consult the .tex file for information on:

Page numbers

Link colours

Spacing between sections

Repetition and indentation

Repeat the headings, items and sub-items as often as required.

Use as many indentation levels as you want, such as 2em, 4em, 6em and 8em.

Use the newpage command to create page breaks where required.

The next sub-item is a long one to show how indentation is maintained throughout the paragraph.

Note that once we have started to use an indentation level, like the 2em and 4em levels used here, we simply type individual items with blank lines between them. But when we have finished using a level we must close the use of it by inserting a closing curly bracket. Each indentation level starts afresh from the left margin. They are not nested or relative to one another. You can see this on the .tex file.
